GLASSDOOR

St Margaret's parish involvement in winter night shelters, in partnership with the charity 'Glassdoor' across the Borough of Richmond - UPDATE

Many of you will have heard Fr Peter's announcement at Sunday mass last week about this exciting partnership. We have just received news from Glassdoor that the opening of St Margaret's winter shelter will be deferred until January 2022. This is to keep in line with local public health guidelines on management of Covid in the Borough of Richmond. Glassdoor will be opening shelters on a staggered basis across London so that they can evaluate data on their demand as well as their success and safety. We hope to be given the go ahead for our site to get started in the New Year.

Plan for January 2022:

Along with 6 other churches within the Richmond shelter weekly circuit we will be hosting guests who need a warm bed and a place to sleep each night with the charity GlassDoor (<https://www.glassdoor.org.uk/>) from January- April 2022.

Covid measures:

All shelters will be managed in line with Government protocols, which include all guests, volunteers and support staff having been fully vaccinated, as well as social distancing, mask wearing, ventilation and general hygiene measures.

We need volunteers:

We have been allocated **Monday nights** during the season which will run from January to April. We are looking for volunteers to become involved in a range of tasks to help the evenings run smoothly depending on their availability and wish to become involved. **On the night, these tasks include welcoming our guests from around 6pm, serving tea and coffee, cooking part of a 3 course meal (a veg soup, a main meal, a cake or desert) and helping to clear/wash up.** You can decide whether you are just able to commit to some of the dates, or all if you have more time.

For those not able to help on site but still wanting to be involved, we will be setting up a SOUP and BAKING rota, and will also need some help with shopping/ sourcing donations.

We will also be collecting donations of tea, coffee, biscuits and items for our hygiene boxes.

Please get in touch if you would like to be involved as we get our teams up and running. We know that our collective effort to re-open shelters will prove a lifeline for many people in dire need of help this winter.
