



At Caritas we are starting to hear of Ukrainian refugees arriving in the diocese. JRS have shared a link to Home Office figures showing the



numbers and breakdown of Ukrainian arrivals. According to this, as at the 3<sup>rd</sup> May 414 visas had been issued for the Homes for Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme for Richmond. Homes for Ukraine sponsorship scheme – numbers of visas issued - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

It's possible that some of these refugees will be hosted by your parishioners, or that your parishioners will want to support their friends and people in the wider community who will be hosting.
