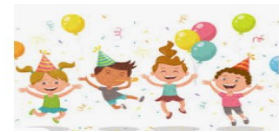
Looking for a party venue?

Twickenham Repair Cafe - Next event is Saturday 21st May

Get there early as we are sure to be pretty busy, we have already had interest from people with all sorts of weird and wonderful stuff for us to repair! We just can't wait!

25 repairers with a huge range of skills and generously give their time and expertise.

With talented IT experts and bike repairers to keep your bike running safely and for longer.

We have already had **130** repairs over three sessions.

With **60** different types of items, from: iPad, Nespresso machine, sewing machine, jumper with holes in, laptop, silver teapot with broken leg, many bikes, ripped jeans, garden strimmer, teddy with holes in hat, wind-up clock, hairdryer, foot massager, wooden birdhouse, lamp, suitcase, walkman, sharpening for tools and knives and even a lightsaber - very difficult but we did it!

At Caritas we are starting to hear of Ukrainian refugees arriving in the diocese. JRS have shared a link to Home Office figures showing the numbers and breakdown of Ukrainian arrivals. According to this, as at the 3rd May 414 visas had been issued for the Homes for Ukraine Sponsorship Scheme for Richmond.
