

# Helpers needed to be on a rota to serve tea/coffee after 1030 am Sunday Mass



The opportunity to meet each other socially is an important part of our parish community life and the "sliding

doors" between the Mass room and the social area were a key concept of architectural design of the church, envisaged more than 50 years ago. "Build the community and then we will build the church" famously declared Fr Sidney Dommerson, parish priest in the 1960s.

With Fran & Joe having moved to Scotland, we now need a rota of "teams" who will be on duty once a month. What's involved?

- Arrive about 20 minutes before Mass to set up the teas/coffees in the kitchen, turn on the hot water heaters/prep the dishwasher, etc.
- Serving the teas/coffees from approx 1130 -1200
- Clearing away/sweeping the floor etc approx 1215 - 1230 so that the hall is left clean and tidy for the next user.
