THANK YOU for all your donations for the parish Lenten Almsgiving.

Last week we presented cheques to our chosen charities who were very grateful for our generous support of their work.

We raised nearly £5900 with a further £1060 to come from Gift Aid. This was split between the two charities. A parishioner has also generously donated a further £3,000 (+ £375 gift aid) directly to the Madagascan school project.

A very big thank you to all those who came and enjoyed our soup lunch on 12th May, and to the volunteers who



once again generously gave their time and expertise to make it such a success. A total of £125 was raised for the benefit of the educational initiatives of Fr Paul Bigirwa in Uganda, including sponsorship of older students - those in the equivalent of our 6th Form (16-19 years old.)

The difficult decision has been taken to cancel the next scheduled soup lunches in June and July due to a number of difficulties which proved too much to

resolve at this time, and there are no plans at the moment to resume in September. Thank you to everyone who has supported the soup lunches over the past
