

CHORISTER OPPORTUNITIES AT WESTMINSTER CATHE-DRA CHOIR SCHOOL



Westminster Cathedra Choir school is looking for boys with musical potential in Years 2,3 or 4, who might consider becoming choristers at Westminster Cathedral.

Every September Westminster Cathedral Choir School welcomes up to six choristers into Years 4 or 5. Becoming a chorister at Westminster Cathedral offers boys the opportunity to sing both here in central London and on tour internationally, in one of the world's great choirs. Boys also receive an outstanding education at one of London's leading schools, up until end of Year 8.

Choristers board during the School week only, heading home to their families from Friday afternoon until Sunday morning at 9.45 am.

The Memoria of Our Lady of Lourdes. There will be a Mass for the Sick at the Cathedral at 2.30pm, celebrated by the Cardinal, during which Anointing of the Sick will be offered. To help us with plan-



ning for the Mass and the anointing, please can you book tickets through the simple booking system, using the link below.

Tickets are in three categories:

- 1. Wheelchair users who require anointing
- 2. Walking sick who require anointing

**3.** Those assisting the sick, who do not require anointing.

These categories of tickets (which will be differently coloured) will also assist the priests at Mass in determining who requires anointing, and this is something we ask for your help in discerning as people request the tickets through you.

Your tickets will be posted to you directly from the Precentors Office. Please note that when you have booked your tickets you will see a message saying 'your tickets will be waiting for you at the venue's pick-up location on the day of the event.' Unfortunately, this a message we cannot remove from the Eventbrite website platform. Again, tickets will be sent to you in the post.
