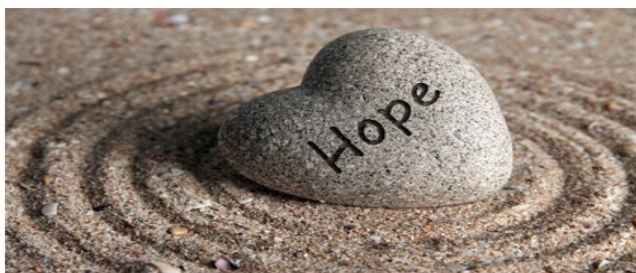

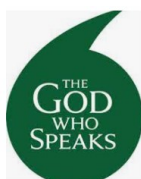
Crossway Pregnancy Crisis Centre in Twickenham is running an 8 week baby loss support programme for couples starting from February 2022.
